Eligibility

- 1. A pass in two year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:
 - i. Physical Sciences
 - ii. Mathematics
- 2. The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in **Telangana State EAMCET-2021**. The candidates will be selected based on merit by following rule of reservation.
- 3. The candidates for admission to these courses shall be required to have completed 17 years of age with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates, 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates and 27 years for Physically Handicapped candidates as on 31st December of the year of admission.

Criteria for selection:

- The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the **Telangana State EAMCET-2021** (Including self-financing seats) conducted by the **Telangana State Council for Higher Education**.
- In case of a tie in ranks obtained by two or more candidates in the Telangana State EAMCET-2021, the marks secured in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination (Intermediate or its Equivalent Examination) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidate shall be given preference.

Reservation of Seats:

- The rule of reservation (OC:50%, EWS:10%, BC-A:7%, BC-B;10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC:15%, ST:6%) will be followed as per the rules.
- The rule of reservation in respect of EWS will be followed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time.

Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturist cum Rural Area (Farmers' Quota) in B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering) (Regular & Self-financing) & B.Tech. (Food Technology) (Regular & Self-financing) courses:

- Forty per cent (40%) of the seats in the PJTSAU are reserved for candidates coming from families of Agriculturists (Farmers) owning not less than ONE acre of land either in the name of the parents or in the name of the candidates and who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.
- > If the land is owned by grandfather, grandmother or guardian or any other relations is not acceptable under farmer quota.
- ANNEXURE-I: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head Master of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).
- ANNEXURE-II: It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate / parents duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal (or) the candidate has to upload attested photocopies of pattadar pass book as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
- ➤ ANNEXURE-I and ANNEXURE-II need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution and Tahsildar, respectively, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from Rural Area (Rural Quota) in B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science (Regular & Self-financing) course:

- Forty per cent (40%) of the seats are reserved for candidates who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.
- ANNEXURE -I: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head Master of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (Non-Municipal Area Certificate) (ANNEXURE I).
- ANNEXURE -I need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution respectively, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

Reservation of Special category seats:

• The counselling for the Physically Challenged (PH@3%), Children of Armed Personnel (CAP@2%), National Cadet Corps (NCC@1%) & SPORTS(@0.5%) quota seats shall be conducted in presence of the Officers of the departments concerned. The certificates of the candidates of above special categories shall be verified by the officers and the seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by them. The University has no interference in indicating priorities.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of Admission:

- SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- Telangana State EAMCET-2021 Hall Ticket and Rank Card.
- Bonafide / Study Certificate from 6th to 12th Class.
- Transfer Certificate.
- Residential Certificate.
- The latest certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana State in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- The latest certified copy of the EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana State in case of applicants belonging to EWS.
- Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I).
- Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II).

Important Instructions:

- This notification shall be treated as individual intimation. No separate intimation will be sent.
- Open Competition includes all categories viz., OC, BC, SC & ST (by merit only).
- The candidates are required to produce all the relevant original certificates at the time of counselling failing which the candidature for admission will be disqualified.
- The selected candidates will have to pay an amount of Rs. 37,840/- requisite fees including deposits immediately failing which the seat will stand cancelled.

- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for the Academic Year 2021-22 an amount of Rs. 1,000/- shall be deducted as processing fee and the remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat After closure of admissions process for the AY 2021-22 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid and in addition, he/she has to pay processing fee of Rs. 1,000/-.
- Selection of candidates under BC, SC & ST quota is subject to clearance by the respective social status by the respective Directorates of Government of Telangana.
- The guidelines issued by Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously.
- Candidates called for counselling shall have to attend at their own cost and only one parent / guardian of the candidate will be allowed to accompany the candidate during counselling.
- The University doesn't guarantee any employment to the candidates joining the course.
- Candidates are required to read the prospectus thoroughly before attending the counselling.
- It is likely that counselling process may extend late into the evening, hence the candidates and parents/ guardians are requested to come well prepared.
- More number of candidates than availability of seats are called for Counselling and hence mere attendance / participation during counselling does not guarantee admission.
- Candidates should report at the Counselling center one hour before the scheduled time.
- Certificates / documents other than those uploaded will not be entertained or considered for the allotment of seats.
- Candidates belonging to BC, SC & ST Categories should bring two sets of Xerox copies of their caste certificate to be submitted at the counselling center.
- 15% of seats in B.Tech.(Agricultural Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology) & B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science under ICAR quota will be filled up by ICAR through the online counselling based on ranks obtained in UG-AIEEA-2021 examination conducted at national level. The seats left over under ICAR quota will not be filled up by the University.
- The selection of the candidates **under Self-financing quota** shall be based on the ranks obtained in TS EAMCET-2021 duly following the rule of reservation with fee structure as indicated in the prospectus. The rule of reservation under farmers quota (@40%) will also apply for **Self-financing** quota seats. **The notification for these seats will be issued separately**.
- The candidates selected for admission should submit Medical fitness certificate at the time of reporting in the college.
