- All categories means the candidates belonging to OC, EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC- Group-II, SC- Group-III and ST including Non-Farmers / Farmers / Agricultural Labourers.
- The candidates need to attend the counselling on the scheduled day as per the ranks indicated above.
- All the applicants under Non-Farmers' / Agricultural Labourers' / Farmers' Quota belonging to OC, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-E, SC-I, SC-II, SC-III & EWS are called for counselling as per the above mentioned schedule.

- The parents and candidates are requested to attend the counselling based on the vacancy position and availability of seats.
- The parents and candidates should visit the University website www.pjtau.edu.in regularly during the counselling dates for updates and availability of seats under various categories.
- Counselling for filling up the seats under Special Quota will be conducted separately.

❖ **Reservation of seats under Farmers' and Agricultural Labourers' Quota**

The seats for the candidates coming from the families of Agriculturalists (Farmers' Quota), and Agricultural Labourers' (Agricultural Labourers' Quota), have been reserved in various UG courses being offered by PJTAU. The details regarding reservation of seats under Farmers' and Agricultural Labourers' quotas in UG courses are given below.

Note:

- **ANNEXURE-I:** It is a **proforma to be certified by the Head of the Institution(s) with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).**
- **ANNEXURE-II:** It is a **proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate/parent(s),** duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal (or) attested photocopies of Pattadar Pass Book as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
- **ANNEXURE-III:** It is a **proforma indicating the Job card (EGS card) number of the candidate/parent(s) and certifying that the candidate/parent(s)/grandparent(s) do not own any Agricultural Land,** duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal.
- **ANNEXURE-I / ANNEXURE-II / ANNEXURE-III** need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., Head of respective Institution(s) and Tahsildar, respectively, along with the office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under respective categories will be summarily rejected.

ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING:

1. Online Application Form.
2. SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
3. Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
4. Telangana EAPCET-2026 Rank Card of Agriculture Stream.
5. Bonafide/Study Certificate(s) from 1st to 12th Class.
6. Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
7. Residence Certificate of Telangana.
8. The certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, and Scheduled Tribes.
9. The latest certified copy of the **EWS Certificate valid for the year 2026-27** issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to the EWS category.
10. Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I), if applicable.
11. Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II), if applicable.
12. Legal heir certificate, if applicable.
13. Certificate claiming Agricultural Labourers' Quota (ANNEXURE-III), if applicable.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS: -

- Candidates are required to read the prospectus thoroughly before attending the counselling.
- The parents and candidates should visit the University website www.pjtau.edu.in regularly during the counselling dates for updates.
- All the candidates are informed to visit the website (www.pjtau.edu.in) for seat availability position before attending the counselling, which will be updated regularly during the counselling days.
- This notification shall be treated as an individual intimation and no separate intimation shall be issued
- All Categories means the candidates belonging to OC, EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC- Group-II, SC- Group-III and ST including Non-Farmers, Farmers and Agricultural Labourers.
- The candidates need to attend the counselling on the scheduled day as per the ranks indicated above.
- The candidates are required to produce all the relevant original certificates at the time of counselling failing which the candidature for admission shall be rejected.
- The selected candidates will have to pay the requisite fees inclusive of deposits immediately failing which the seat shall stand cancelled.

Fee:

The fee particulars of PJTAU U.G. Programmes are as follows:

- The hostel and mess charges are additional/extra.
- Hostel accommodation shall be provided subject to availability.
- If the admitted candidate cancels/withdraws his/her seat before the closure of admission process, the entire fee collected from the student shall be refunded in full after deducting Rs. 2,000/- as processing fee.
- Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions after the closure of the admission process, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fees (except the caution deposits). In addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 2,000/- as processing fee.

- Selection of candidates under EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC- Group-II, SC- Group-III & ST quota is subject to clearance of the respective social status by the respective Directorates of Government of Telangana.
- In the event of establishment of new colleges such seats shall also be considered for filling up through this notification only.
- The guidelines issued by Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously.
- Counselling is held manually, not online counselling.
- Candidates called for counselling shall have to attend at their own cost and only one parent / guardian of the candidate will be allowed to accompany the candidate during the counselling process.
- The Universities do not guarantee any employment to the candidates joining the courses.
- The counseling process is likely to extend late into the evening; hence the candidates and parents/ guardians are requested to come well prepared for the same.
- More number of candidates than the available seats are called for counseling and hence, mere attendance / participation during counselling does not guarantee admission.
- Candidates should report at the counselling center one hour before the scheduled time.
- Candidates belonging to EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC- Group-II, SC- Group-III & ST categories should bring two Xerox copies of their relevant certificate to be submitted at the counselling center.
- The seats reserved under EWS/ BC / SC-Group-I / SC- Group-II / SC- Group-III /ST categories including Non-Farmers' / Farmers' / Agricultural Labourers' Quota shall also be filled up simultaneously during the counseling process on the scheduled days.
- Sliding and shifting from one course to another course and one college to another college shall be done based on the merit and rule of reservation and availability of seats.
- 20% of seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture under ICAR quota shall be filled up based on ranks obtained in UG-CUET-2026 National level examination conducted by National Testing Agency.
- The left-over seats under ICAR quota shall be filled up by the University.
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University shall take appropriate legal action against the individuals concerned.
- The University is not responsible for any information provided in the websites other than at www.pjtau.edu.in.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University and as such they are requested not to rely on any middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into PJTAU under any quota. All the seats shall be filled by the University only through combined counselling.
- The candidates may take original certificates on request by furnishing an undertaking, if they have any other counsellings to be attended and return the certificates after the stipulated day. If they fail to return the certificates to the college, the admission shall stand cancelled. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
- The selected candidates are advised to take mobile numbers of the concerned officers of the allotted college for official information.
- Candidates are informed to attend counselling on the scheduled date and time. If they fail to attend, they cannot claim the seat as per merit.
- Candidates, if attend the counselling late, they shall have to submit the letter to the counselling authorities duly indicating the time of their attending the counselling.
